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### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. 2017-2020
- 1.2. All classes of Dinghy. The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply
- 1.3. 1.4 and 1.5 only apply to Trailer Yachts and Sports Boats
- 1.4. The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part V Category C shall apply with the exception to sports boats where applicable class rules apply.
- 1.5. Sports boats shall carry an adequate-sized motor and enough fuel to propel themselves to safety in bad weather
- 1.6. Life jackets must be worn at all times while on the water. This changes RRS 40
- 1.7. Safety checks can be made at any time before and during this Regatta

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all owners/ skippers who are financial members of a YNZ or NZTYA affiliated club, class association or an individual member of NZTYA
- 2.2. The regatta is open to all classes of Dinghies, Trailer Yachts, Sports Boats and Cruisers

- 2.3. Trailer yacht racing will be in four divisions A Division, B Division, C Division, Sports Boat Division and Cruising Boats
- 2.4. Entry forms are available on line at marakura.org and at Marakura Yacht Club
- 2.5. Entry Fee for senior Dinghies and Trailer Yachts will be \$30 per boat for the Marakura Easter Regatta with an extra \$20 payable to include entry into the NZ /South Island Trailer Yacht Champs  
Dinghy junior entry fee will be \$15  
**If you enter and are unable to attend there will be a full refund of your entry fee**
- 2.6. Late entries will be accepted at the race committees' discretion
- 2.7. The Race Officer and /or the Race Committee has the right to refuse or accept any entry

### 3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Marakura Yacht Club from 1630 hrs 18<sup>th</sup> April 2019

### 4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1. **Registration:** Thursday 18th April, from 1630hrs at Marakura Yacht Club  
Friday 19th from 930hrs  
Late registrations will also be possible on Saturday 20th and Sunday 21st
- 4.2. **Briefing:** Friday 19th April, 1300hrs at the Marakura Yacht Club, Saturday and Sunday briefing will be at 1000hrs.  
Seven races are scheduled. More may be sailed if the weather permits
- 4.3. Number of races per day will be at the Race Officers' discretion
- 4.4. Dinghies will come into the club rooms for a lunch break  
Trailer Yachts will sail back to back races and will get an opportunity to have lunch out on the water

### 5. COURSE

- 5.1. **Area:** The racing area will be on the southern end of Lake Te Anau
- 5.2. **Courses to be Sailed: Trapezoid with separate finish**  
The courses diagram will be attached to the Sailing Instructions
- 5.3. Dinghies and Trailer Yachts will be sailing on separate race courses

### 6. SCORING

- 6.1. The low points scoring system of Appendix A will be used
- 6.2. Results for Trailer Yachts will be determined by corrected times using the latest NZTYA Ratings  
Results for Dinghies will be determined by corrected times using YNZ handicaps
- 6.3. Two races will be required to be completed to constitute a Series
- 6.4. When fewer than seven races have been completed, no score will be excluded  
Seven or more races: Drop worst score

## 7. PENALTIES

- 7.1. RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two Turns Penalty is replaced by the One Turn Penalty
- 7.2. Decisions of the Race Committee will be final as provided in RSS 70.5
- 7.3. Changes to Racing Rules. The Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with rule 86 as follows. For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing

## 8. CREWS

- 8.1. Crew number and names shall be stipulated on the entry form prior to the first briefing at 1300 hrs on Friday 19th April 2019
- 8.2. Crew numbers and names nominated on the official entry form may not be changed for any race without the express permission of the Race Officer

## 9. TEAM SUPPORT BOATS

- 9.1. No support boat may enter the race area whilst racing is in progress, except to render aid to a vessel in distress

## 10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 10.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones

## 11. LAUNCHING RAMPS

- 11.1. There is one single and one double public ramp. There is a triple ramp in the Te Anau Boating Club compound which is accessible only by key. Keys will be available to gain access to the compound at a cost of \$30 for the weekend. \$10 refundable on return of key

## 12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta.

### 12.2. Decision to Race

The responsibility for a boats decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone
