NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Sailing Instructions means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Yachting New Zealand Prescriptions 2021-2024 shall apply.
- 1.3 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply. In addition, all competitors in the Open Skiff Class shall wear safety helmets whilst on the water.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. [DP]

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all classes of dinghy and Trailer Yachts
- 3.2 Each competitor shall be:
 - (a) a financial member of a club recognised YNZ
 - (b) or a member of the Southland Trailer Yacht Squadron
- 3.5 Late entries will be accepted at the Organizing Authority's discretion until 1000hrs on *9th April 2022*.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is NZ\$15 for juniors and \$30 for senior sailors
- 4.2 Some local boats may be available to charter for a fee of \$100 per boat

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

8.1 A variety of courses will be used including Windward/Leeward, Triangular, Reaching, long race and a combination of these. As defined in the SI or at the daily briefing

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

10 SCORING

10.1 One (1) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2

- a) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When five (5) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- c) When eight (8) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be deemed to be "Event Support Boats" and shall have an operative VHF radio and follow all instructions of the Race Officer.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

13 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of NZ\$1,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
